



## Jewel Case Scrapbook

### Supplies Needed:

- 1 full-sized CD clear jewel case\*, without CD tray
- 1 sheet, themed paper (this provides the inspiration for the album, design decisions are based on this)
- cardstock:
  - album base: 2 pieces of neutral cardstock, cut to 4.5" x 10.5" and scored at 5.25"
  - 1-3 additional colors of cardstock or paper in coordinating colors (to be used as mats and page accents)
- tag and large circle punches (optional-these shapes can be cut freehand or other shapes can be substituted according to your theme)
- coordinating stamps (optional)
- inks in 1-2 coordinating colors (optional)
- lettering (optional: stickers, stamps, etc.)
- heavy thread, embroidery floss, cording or hemp: at least 10"-12"\*\*\*
- wide ribbon, twill tape, etc.: at least 12"-14"\*\*\*



\*This project will NOT work with the slim-style jewel case...please refer to the photo for the style needed.

\*\*\*Both of these are required to complete the album

## Album Body

- 2 pieces of neutral colored cardstock (cut to 10.5" x 4.5", scored & folded at 5.25")

### Cover (page 1)

- 2.75" x 3.25" Cardstock (photo mat)
- 5.25 x 2.75" Themed Paper
- 5.25" x .5" Cardstock strip
- Letters
- Circle (journaling area)

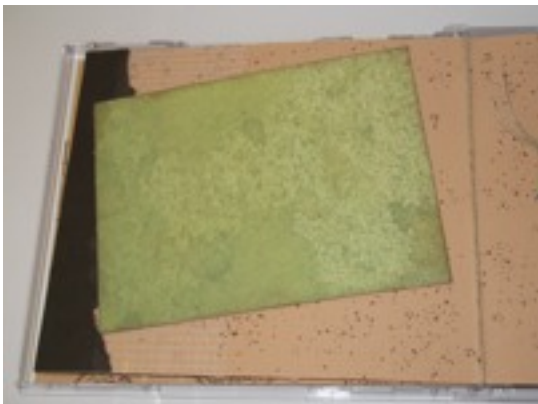


### Page 2

- 2.75" x 3.25" cardstock or paper (photo mat)
- Journaling Tag
- scrap corners (photo corners)
- random themed stamping

### Page 3

- 3.25" x 4" photo mat
- 3" x 4.5" piece (torn to approximately 2.5")
- decorative hemp
- random theme stamping



### Page 4

- 4" x 3.25" photo mat
- 4.5" torn strip
- Magic Mesh/Drywall Tape
- Speckled Background Stamping\*

### Page 5

- .5" x 4.5" strip of Themed Paper
- 3.5" x 3" mat (trimmed to look like a tag)
- twill tape/ribbon
- speckle stamping\*



### Page 6

- 5.25" x 4" strip of Themed Paper, torn & inked
- 2 square photo mats: 2.5"
- 6" of twill:
  - 5.5" of twill is wrapped around the themed paper strip and secured with adhesive on the back, a second piece of twill (4-5") is then knotted carefully around the first and trimmed as desired to give the illusion that the whole piece is tied down.



### Page 7

- 3" x 4.5" strip of themed paper
- .5" x 4.5" strip of colored paper
- 2.75" x 3.25" photo mat
- 2 - 2" pieces of twill/ribbon wrapped around the corners and secured on the back (photo corners)



### Back (Page 8)

- 3.75" x 3.25" photo mat
- 2 circles cut from themed paper (photo tabs)
- small rectangle journaling block
- random stamping or themed paper cut to 5.25" x 4.5"

## Album Assembly

- Stack the cardstock pages and fold on the score lines
- A small amount of adhesive can be applied to the fold if needed
- Gently lay the album in the deeper side of the CD case, face down. The album should look like this, with the back of the album facing up, the left side of the tray filled and the thinner/right side tray empty.
- Close the case and carefully tie with the 12" of twill or ribbon...this can be secured on the back with adhesive if necessary.
- Using 10-12" of cord/hemp/thread secure the album into the Jewel Case: Run the cord through the middle of the album, between the hinges, and OVER the ribbon...tie securely in place.



## Assorted Notes

- Each page size is 5.25" (wide) x 4.5" (tall)
- The deeper side of the CD case is used as the FRONT of the album for this project.
- Any more than 2 pieces of folded cardstock, may be too thick for the Jewel Case to close properly
- Keep in mind the depth of your Jewel Case when choosing your embellishments...if they are too wide/thick the Jewel Case won't close or may even crack!
- The 12" of wide ribbon are used to help keep the Jewel Case closed when not in use, the 10" of cord are used to tie the album INTO the Jewel case.
- When assembling the album, tack the ribbon in place with a glue dot or adhesive on the back of the Jewel Case. Then run the cord (thread, hemp, etc.) through the middle of the album, between the hinges, and OVER the ribbon...tie securely in place.

**Tip:** \*If you do not a Speckle Stamp, try using a stipple brush, sea sponge or plastic wrap...any one of these used with a little ink will create a soft, neutral, textured background.
